Check below to see if your tank is affected by this recall.

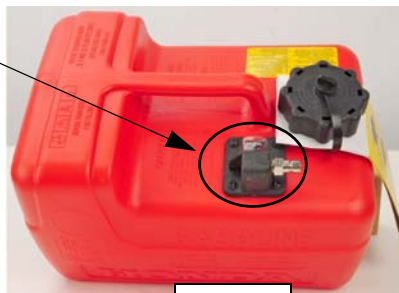
### AFFECTED UNITS

Manufacture Date Stamp Range	
12L: 4/29/11 thru 4/5/12	25L: 4/21/11 thru 3/28/12

A leak may develop in the area around the fuel outlet/gauge.

Small white dot indicates the fuel tank has been repaired and is not affected by this recall.



### What is the problem?

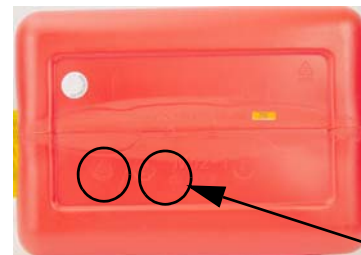
During the installation of the fuel outlet/gauge, the gasket between the tank housing and gauge assembly may have been misaligned or damaged, which could cause a fuel or vapor leak.

### **⚠ WARNING**

Gasoline is highly flammable and explosive.

You can be burned or seriously injured when handling fuel.

- Stop the engine and keep heat, sparks, and flame away.
- Handle fuel only outdoors.
- Wipe up spills immediately.

Examples of how to read the different styles of date stamps.

Style #	Month/Year	Day	Mfg Date
1			6/1/11
2			9/15/11
3			10/9/11

### What should you do?

If you own one of the fuel tanks shown above, you will need to check the manufacture date stamp located on the fuel tank to determine if it is within the affected range. **12L tank:** Close the vent on the fuel cap and turn the fuel tank on its side to view the date stamp on the bottom of the tank. **25L tank:** The date stamp is on the end of the tank. If you do not feel comfortable checking the date stamp, your servicing dealer can assist you. See examples of how to read the date stamp at the right.

If the date stamp is within the affected range, contact your Honda Marine servicing dealer for a replacement fuel tank, free of charge.
